DISTRICT 12 2009 MEMBERSHIP AWARDS PROGRAM

In addition to a continued statewide membership gain for the end of October 2009, Texas Farm Bureau has set a goal of 90% as the statewide average for Renewal Percentage. The key components to membership growth are to acquire new members while retaining the current membership.

In order to reward the County Farm Bureaus and the County Secretaries in District 12 for their success in membership growth, the following Membership Awards Program has been established.

The results of this three part program will be calculated from the TFB October 31, 2009 Membership Progress Report (MPR). The division of the money in each section of this program will be as follows: (#1) \$300, (#2) \$250, (#3) \$200, (#4) \$150 and (#5) \$100.

1. \$1000 will be awarded to the five CFB's having the highest percent increase of new members in '09 over 2008. (See October '09 MPR»-'09 new members divided by the '08 new members).
2. \$1000 will be awarded to the secretaries of the five CFB's having the highest percent membership renewals in 2009. (See the %YTD RENL column in the October '09 MPR)
3. \$1000 will be awarded to the secretaries of the five CFB's having the highest percent increase of renewals in 2009 over their 2008 renewals. (See October '09 MPR—2009 renewals divided by 2008 renewals)

The CFB's receiving award checks will be recognized at the District 12 Caucus at the TFB Convention in December, 2009.

The checks for the Secretaries of the award winning CFB's will also be distributed at the District 12 Caucus. The division of these awards for the secretaries will be determined by that CFB president.

The Board of Directors of Texas Farm Bureau has approved a membership renewal awards program to give you the opportunity to earn additional credit to be used to attend the 2012 American Farm Bureau meeting in Hawaii and to allow County Farm Bureau Secretaries to earn additional money. **Texas Farm Bureau** as a whole **must achieve a 90% member renewal rate** in 2009 in order for any funds to be paid out.

To qualify:

1. The County Farm Bureaus that achieved 90% or better renewal rate in 2008 must only equal their renewal percentage of 2008 in 2009.
2. The County Farm Bureaus that achieved at least an 88% renewal rate, but less than 90% in 2008 must achieve a 90% renewal rate in 2009.
3. The County Farm Bureaus that achieved a renewal rate of less than 88% in 2008 must achieve at least an 88% renewal rate in 2009.
4. Any County Farm Bureau that does not qualify based upon 1,2 or 3 above but increases its renewal rate by at least 3% in 2009 will also qualify.

Awards:

1. County Farm Bureau will receive an additional \$500 toward the 2012 Hawaii incentive plan (this amount is in addition to any other 2009 award).
2. The County Farm Bureau secretary will receive a \$500 award. (One \$500 award to be paid to county secretary (s) as directed by county.)
